Bath Heritage Watchdog objects to this application.

This is the second application relating to signage for the dental practice. Whilst accepting that this application is an improvement on the previously refused one, we remain concerned at the extent of brass signage ie to both sides of the door. The signage relating to opening hours is not considered necessary to the frontage. A simple sign inside the entrance would suffice.

The works proposed are considered to be detrimental to the special architectural and historic character and interest of the listed building, adjacent listed buildings and the conservation area contrary to S16 and S72 of the Planning (Listed Buildings & Conservation Areas) Act 1990, Section 12 'Conserving & Enhancing the Historic Environment of the NPPF and Policies DW1, CP6, D1, D2, D3, D8, D9, D10, and HE1 of the Core Strategy and Placemaking Plan and should be refused in its current format.
