We love seeing rugby played on the Rec, but are not prepared to tolerate a massive stadium and car park dominating the town centre and our World Heritage city.

Bath Rugby's Application to the High Court to overturn the 1922 Covenant restricting development over the Rec, is being defended 'out of pocket' by the occupants of 77 Great Pulteney Street, to represent the many concerned Citizens of Bath.

Numbers are important to the Defence and our London Barrister is asking for a 'show of hands' by means of a contribution - anything from say £5 but no more than £25 - towards the Defence costs. This can be done anonymously through the website at

The Hearing will be held in High Court of Justice in Bristol early in the New Year, following which Bath Rugby will decide whether to make its planning application.
