Fixing of large advertisement panels to front façade, erection of unauthorised gates to side entrance, repainting of doors from red to black and blocking up of white framed windows, with that boarding subsequently painted black.

The building is Grade II listed, particularly for the main frontage which exhibits the pockmarking from bomb and shrapnel damage. The signs are particularly inappropriate as the building is considered a monument to those who lived through this period in Bath's history. Both planning permissions have Conditions requiring the preservation of the exterior.
