LBC is also required for a change and new signage which affects the character of the listed asset. The offset lettering which has been added in two places – Lymore Terrace and to the significant corner turret (which has caused significant damage due to new drillings with previous drillings and red rawlplugs clearly visible). There are a number of other signs on walls and doors, which is excessive. The school is well known and on a prominent corner and we consider the signage installed to be both physically and aesthetically damaging, as are the visible fixings for the previous signs.
